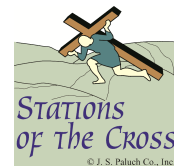

All this snow -- but a sign of hope -- with this Wednesday being Ash Wednesday, we know that Easter is only forty days away, and if Easter is around the corner, then Spring must be too. Masses on Ash Wednesday will be at 6:15 and 8:30am, and 12:15, 4:30, and 7:30pm. Next Sunday we will begin our new Sunday schedule, as announced last weekend -- see the cover for time changes. Throughout Lent we will have Confessions every Wednesday evening from 6:30 to 8:00pm (as part of the diocese-wide "The Light is On For You" campaign), Thursdays during Holy Hour, and Saturdays from 4:00 to 5:00pm. Our Eucharistic Holy Hour will move to Thursday evenings, beginning at 7:30pm, and Stations of the Cross will be prayed every Friday beginning at 7:30pm. I hope that this Lenten season may be a truly prayerful time for us all as we enter more deeply into the Paschal Mystery. During this season I ask that you pray in a special way for the men and women who will be received into the Church at the Easter Vigil.
